

According to one, poor communication skills cost companies an average of \$62.4 million annually.*; second stated that improper communication was the root cause of 70% of workplace accidents and errors.** A third study found that 37% of professionals and managers feel that they miss out on opportunities due to poor communication skills.+++

We are sure with an extensive background in Learning and Development (L&D), sales and a profound understanding of B2B business cycles, Srinivas will push SoME to greater heights and success.



Endurance, Alfred Lansing






